The Oswego County Historical Society was organized in 1896. Since then it has been working to collect, preserve, and interpret materials and objects germane to the history of Oswego County. The Society operates the Richardson-Bates House Museum which is listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

The museum contains five period rooms, a permanent exhibit on Oswego County History, and a gallery for changing exhibits.

The Society offers curriculum tools for teachers and students throughout Oswego County. The museum maintains a local history and special collection library containing thousands of images and documents.

The museum is responsible for the preservation of important artifacts which document the lives and activities of Oswego County residents from 1797 to the present.
